

2010 Okemos Athletic Boosters (OAB)

Club 13 – Expect the Unexpected Helicopter Ball Drop Rules

1. For an entry fee of \$20.00 (per ball), or buy five get one free, each participant will be entered into Okemos Athletic Boosters (OAB) Golf Ball Drop to take place on March 13, 2010 at the Country Club of Lansing. Participants may enter more than once. Participants will be assigned a numbered golf ball(s) based on their ticket number.

2. On March 13, 2010 the golf balls will be placed randomly in a bag and dropped from a Helicopter onto the 18th green, at the Country Club of Lansing. The participant whose numbered golf ball goes into the target hole first or is the closest to the hole will win:

\$2,000.00 (Two Thousand Dollars) in Cash

3. If multiple balls go in the hole, the ball on the bottom will be considered to have gone in first and will be the winner.

4. If no balls go in the hole then the ball landing closest to the hole will be the winner. The ball closest to the hole will be determined by measuring in a straight line from the center of the hole to the ball. If there is more than one ball that is the same distance closest to the hole, then all the balls that are tied will be randomly put in a bag and a ball drawn to determine a winner.

5. The participant whose numbered golf ball is the furthest from the hole is the second prize winner. The ball furthest from the hole will be determined by measuring in a straight line from the center of the hole to the ball. This will be determined by the judge(s) and will be the numbered ball(s) that are able to be found at the time of the golf ball drop. If there is more than one ball that is the same distance furthest from the hole, then all the balls that are tied will be randomly put in a bag and a ball drawn to determine a winner. The second prize winner will win:

\$1,000.00 (One Thousand Dollars) in Cash

6. The winners will be announced at the event as soon as the judge(s) determine the winners. If the winners are not present, they will be notified by contact information supplied on the raffle ticket within 24 hours.

Winners need not be present to win.

7. If the event should be cancelled for any reason, the winners will be determined by a raffle with all of the participants entered. Golf balls will be placed randomly in a bag. The first ball that is drawn will receive \$2,000.00 and be the First Prize Winner and the second ball that is drawn will win \$1,000.00 and will be the Second Prize Winner.

- The event is open to participants 18 years and older as of entry date.

- Winners will be notified by phone, mail or email based on contact information supplied. If a winner cannot be located or fails to claim the prize within ten (10) days after notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner using a random drawing.
- OAB assumes no responsibility for late, lost, stolen, damaged, misdirected, incomplete or illegible entries.
- All entries become the property of OAB and will not be returned.
- By entering the raffle, winner consents, without limitation or additional compensation, to the use of their name, voice, photograph, likeness and/or entry for advertising and/or trade purposes, except where prohibited by law.
